All School

An Update From the Head of School

We've heard from several of you over the last few weeks, and I want to make sure we move forward in partnership with open lines of communication. In that spirit, I will take the opportunity for the next few weeks to provide an update on items of importance in these fluid times. As a parent, I know that my children's school can flood my inbox with daily messages. To streamline and provide consistent, thoughtful, timely, and thorough information, I ask that you continue to rely on and read *Wolf Watch* each week. As we transition from summer to the school year, we make every effort to place important news and announcements into *Wolf Watch* every Sunday so our parents know where to go for important updates and information.

This week, I wanted to provide you with a brief update on the metrics we will monitor related to our re-entry plan. While we are not following a single set of data points or prescriptive advice—as that is not in the best interest of St. Francis—we continue to assess the COVID-19 trends for the Greater Houston area as provided by the Texas Medical Center. These include:

- R t (effective reproduction rate) of the virus
- ICU bed capacity under Phase 1
- Daily positive new cases
- Average percentage of positive tests per day
- Average number of hospitalizations per day

Additionally, once staff and students return to campus, we will continue to monitor conditions and trends for re-entry, along with information specific to the St. Francis Episcopal School community, such as numbers of absences across cohorts, grade levels, divisions, and staff; positive COVID-19 cases within our community; and other trends in exposures. In anticipation of our students' return to campus, St. Francis has developed possible COVID scenarios that we may encounter during the school

year. [These scenarios](#) should help with planning and clarifying when you should keep your child at home. Please print this document to use as a guideline. You may also contact your student's division nurse if you have additional questions.

We remain on track for Primary and Lower School to begin in-person instruction on **Wednesday, September 9**, and for Middle and Upper School to begin in-person instruction (with a gradual re-entry) **September 14–18**.

It will take all of us to continue partnering together. Please continue to wear a mask, stay socially distant, and wash your hands thoroughly and often. Together, we can make a difference and live our mission to be *people for others*.

And remember, please **join me on Thursday, September 3, as we kick off our Community Connections series** for the 2020–21 school year. I will answer as many questions as possible and provide further updates on our re-entry plans. You can submit your questions by e-mailing Info@StFrancisHouston.org.

Select Your Learning Model

As we prepare to welcome our students back to campus, we are asking **all families** to let us know their preferred learning model by **Wednesday, September 2, at noon**. (This request includes our Primary and Lower School families, as we realize circumstances may have changed since early August.)

There will be a waiver to sign upon completing your selection and, once again, we recommend choosing the option that works for your child and family. Additionally, we know you may need to adjust your learning model at some point during the school year. You can switch between on-campus or comprehensive distance learning as needed at two-week intervals by e-mailing your student's division head.

I hope this finds you well and enjoying your weekend. We are so blessed to have avoided Hurricane Laura, but we continue to pray for those who were not so fortunate.

The faculty was amazed with how well your children handled remote learning this week, despite the hurricane interference later in the week. They are reporting that the kiddos are focused, independent, eager to learn, and excited to be back in school, even remotely. It is especially remarkable to see how well our kindergarten friends are working independently and enjoying getting to know their teachers and new friends.

Thank you for your support at home. Students are using their “home offices” and headphones and making sure to have all needed materials handy. We are seeing them persevere through challenges, and they are speaking up when they need help. Thank you for allowing them to work independently and to take charge of their own remote-learning experience. We also appreciate you reaching out to the teachers when there is an issue.

Here is the silver lining of this trying time: our students are learning resilience, displaying grit and independence, and demonstrating problem-solving skills. These are lifelong skills that will take them far. We, of course, want our students to master academic concepts, but being able to utilize these social-emotional competencies makes all of their academic learning that much easier.

As a mom, I know it’s hard to watch your child struggle; it’s much easier to jump in and solve the problem at hand. Allow your child to have these learning moments by letting her/him navigate the remote-learning experience. If you or another caretaker are still sitting with your child during class, please try to take a step back, letting your child work independently. Tackling a challenge and experiencing success promotes a sense of accomplishment and self-confidence. The teachers will alert you if we need you to jump in and help. We will continue to work together to make this the best possible situation!
