### **NUTS AND BOLTS**

**Date:** Wednesday, November 18

**Gate Opens for Entry:** 6:15 p.m.

**Movie Start Time:** 7:00 p.m.

**Venue:** Moonstruck Drive-In (100 Bringhurst St., Houston, TX 77020)

**Restrooms:** Air-conditioned, temporary toilets will be available; social-distanced line

**Audience:** Upper School families

**Program Length:** 1 hour

**COVID Protocol:** All persons in attendance must remain in their own vehicles unless needing to use the restroom. For the safety of the community, there will be no exceptions. Masks are required.

### **FAQs**

#### **Will this be the only chance to see the films?**

Yes. You will want to be there to see what everyone is talking about on Thursday morning!

#### **Do I *really* have to stay in my car? I want to jump into my friend's car and say "hi" just for a minute!**

Why risk it? Let's model respect for the rules and do our part. If the rule is broken, the entire vehicle and the occupants will be asked to leave by HPD. You must remain in the vehicle you arrived in at all times unless traveling to and from the restroom.

#### **Do I have to wear a mask in my own car?**

Yes, if the windows are down, all occupants must wear a mask. If the windows are up, you can unmask.

#### **I drive a pickup truck. Can I sit in the bed of the truck?**

Yes. That is considered "inside" a vehicle. However, you must remain masked because you are in the open air. Opening the liftgate of an SUV is permissible, but masks for all occupants are required to be worn if the liftgate is open.

#### **Where do I park, and do I keep my car on?**

Each car will occupy one parking spot and will be assigned a slot. It is acceptable to back into the spot. Headlights must be turned off, but cars can remain running. Under no circumstances will changing passengers between cars be allowed upon entering the venue.

**How will I hear the movie with the windows up?**

The audio is played over the FM radio. You will be given a station to turn to on your FM radio. An FM radio is required to hear the audio; it will not be streamed off a music service such as Spotify or have Bluetooth compatibility.

**Will there be a concession stand?**

No, the concession stand will not be open.

**Why are the tickets \$40?**

The venue is handling all ticketing. St. Francis has rented the facility, the equipment, security, etc., but the rental agreement stipulates that each vehicle has a ticket. The price is set by the venue. St. Francis does not have control over pricing, nor does St. Francis collect any ticket revenue. Please note that one ticket covers all of the vehicle occupants, and individual tickets for vehicle occupants are not needed. The capacity of a vehicle corresponds directly to the number of seatbelts in the vehicle.

**I bought a ticket for the wrong movie—can you help me?**

Lucky you! You get to go to two drive-in movies! The venue states that "All ticket transactions are final; no refunds or exchanges will be given. Please make sure you have the correct date and films chosen before you check out."

**I bought a ticket; do they mail it to me?**

You can use your e-mail receipt confirmation as your entry ticket. When you place your order, ensure that you have the correct e-mail as your confirmation e-mail. This e-mail serves as your ticket into the drive-in. The venue does not accept screenshots of the e-mail; it must be the original e-mail to gain entry.

**Will there be security?**

Yes, HPD will be providing security for the event.

**What if it rains?**

This event will take place rain or shine!
