Drop Off Your Student's Medications Before Wednesday

If your child needs to have medicine during school hours, you must drop the medication off to the school nurse on your student's campus before the first day of school (Wednesday, August 18). This includes EpiPens, inhalers, over-the-counter creams or ointments, and prescription medications.

- Medication must be in the original container.
- The school clinic staff will assist with the required Medication Permission Form that you must sign. Some medication will require additional signed documentation from your physician.
